R. L. POLK & CO'S CHICAGO STREET AND AVENUE GUIDE

The City comprises Eleven Divisions, known as the North, South and West Divisions, Hyde Park, Lakeview, Jefferson, Norwood Park, Austin, and Rogers Park.

The new house numbering plan passed by the City Council June 22, 1908, in force and effect September 1, 1909, makes Madison Street from Lake Michigan to the city limits on the west the base line for numbering all north and south streets and streets running in northerly or southerly direction.

The original ordinance did not include the so-called down town district, bounded on the north and west by the river, on the south by 12th street and on the east by Lake Michigan, but on June 20, 1910 the ordinance was amended to bring the down town district into the general plan both as to numbers and prefixes, to become effective April 1, 1911.

Eight hundred (800) numbers are assigned to each mile, or one hundred (100) numbers to each one-eighth of a mile. Commencing with No. 1 at the north line of Madison Street, the numbers run north at this rate for Lake Michigan or the northern city limits, and similarly, south of Madison Street on streets running north and south, the numbers commence with No. 1 at the south line of Madison and run to the southern city limits, in a like manner numbers on east and west streets commence with No. 1 at the west line of State Street and run east to the city limits, and with No. 1 at the west line of State Street and run west to the city limits. The prefixes of the streets that intersect with the base line, State Street, are usually even. For example, to find 104 S. State, it will be seen that 100 is on the corner of Monroe and 122 is on the corner of Clark and 104 is between these two streets. Where no numbers are given, the corners, and often the blocks, are vacant.

On any street, the relative location of a house is found by running down the column of figures, which are its numbers at the several crossings of the streets that intersect with it. The last number after crossing is usually even. For example, to find 104 S. State, it will be seen that 100 is on the corner of Monroe and 122 is on the corner of Clark and 104 is between these two streets. Where no numbers are given, the corners, and often the blocks, are vacant.
