

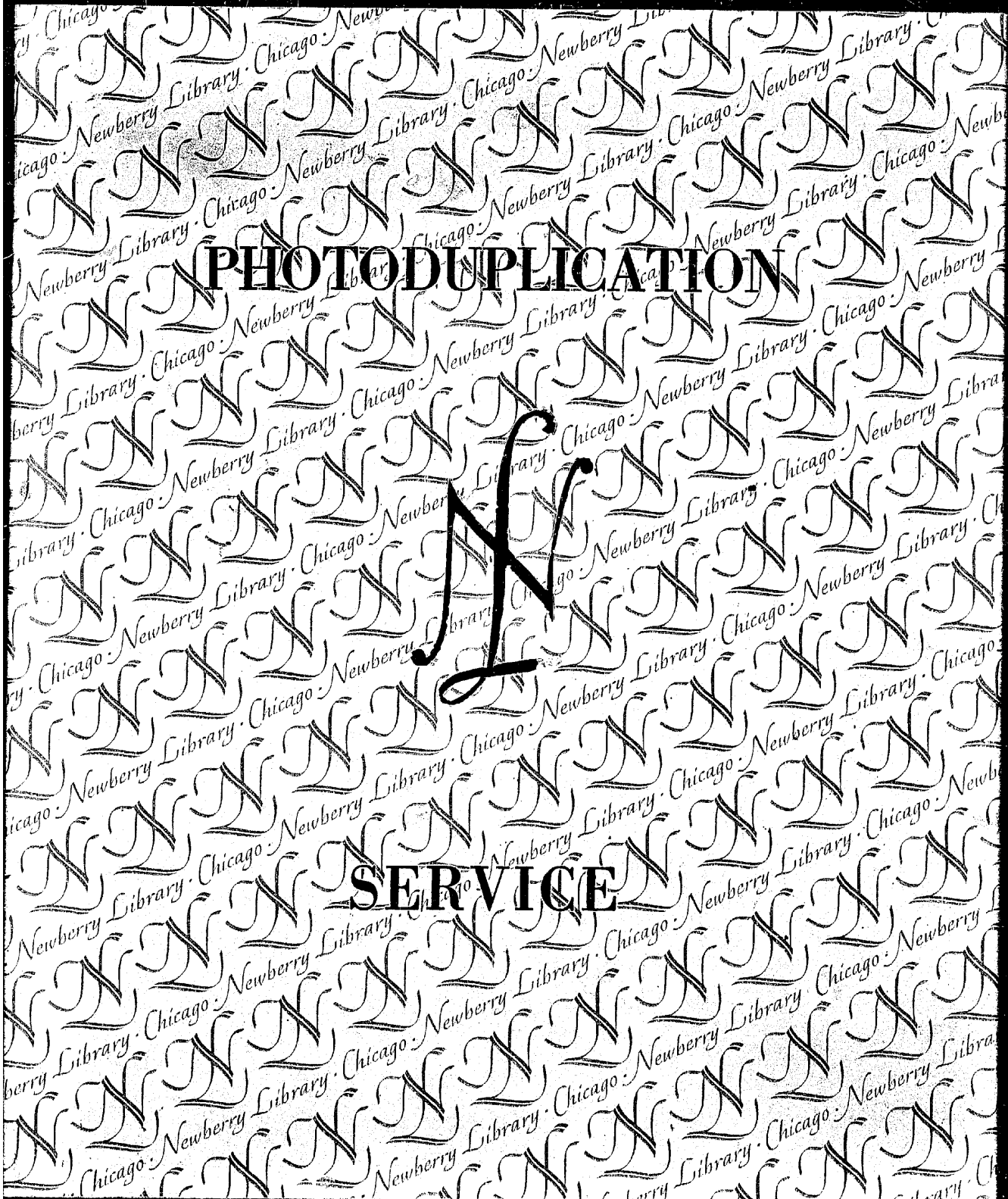

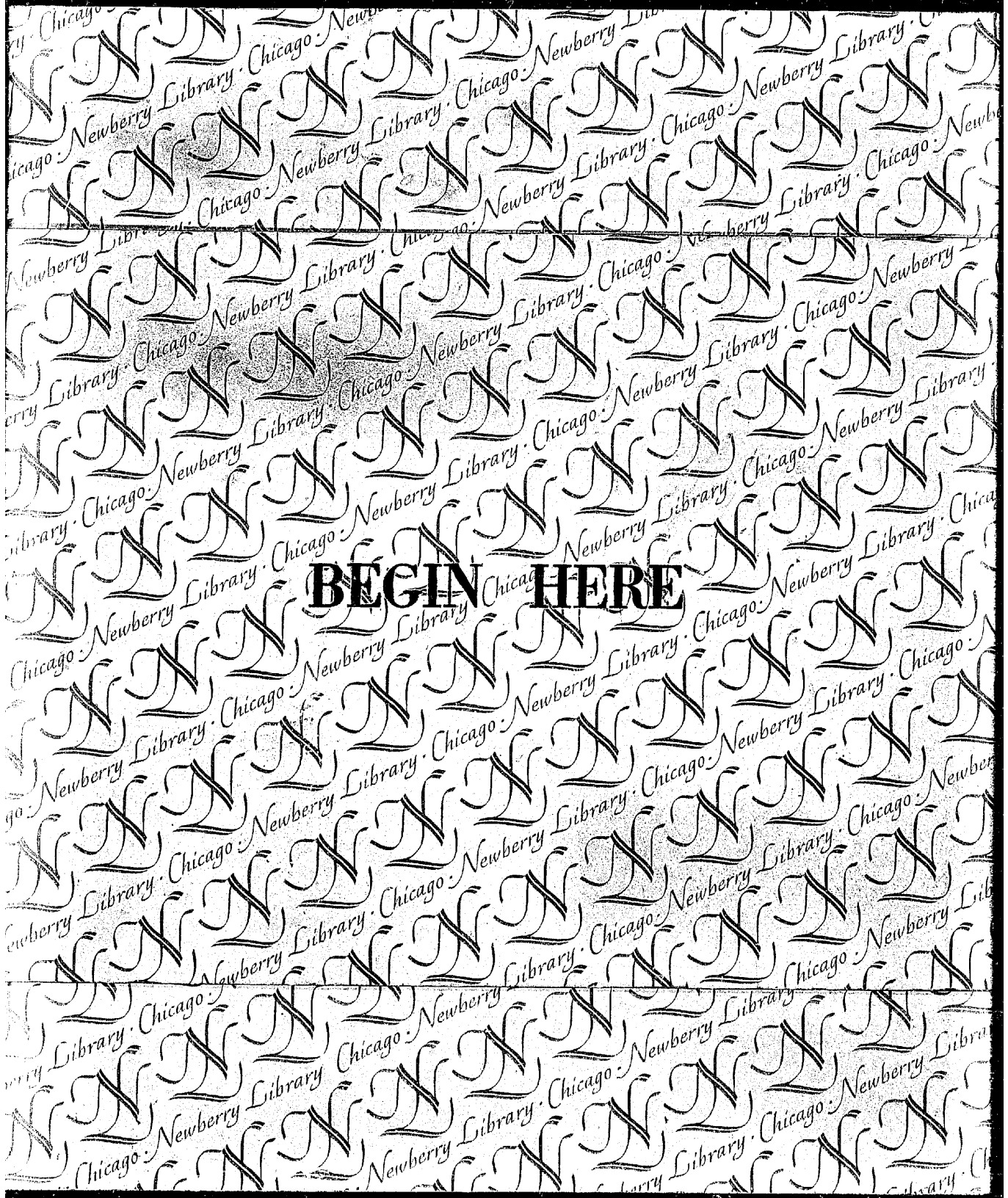

## PREFACE.

The people of Chicago may well contemplate without shame their part in the century now drawing to a close. Not least significant in the brief and wonderful span of our country's progress is the growth of Chicago.

The record of these years, their deeds, opportunities, and achievements, is history; it does not belong in these pages. Yet it is in place that in presenting to the public this final volume of the century, we should express the pride that all Chicago shares in the knowledge that our population has passed the two-million mark.

In making this computation, we have taken as a basis the Directory, the United States and the School Censuses of 1890, and carried forward from year to year the ratio of names to population, checking, correcting, and verifying our estimates by every means at command. With the utmost confidence in the accuracy and reliability of these methods, we announce Chicago's population as 2,010,000.

The 1900 Directory contains about 584,000 names, the greatest number that has ever appeared in a Directory in the United States, and about 185,000 more than are contained in the Directory of any other city. We trust that the magnitude and difficulty of the compilation may serve as our apology in the event of possible errors and omissions, and that, not less than heretofore, we may deserve the confidence and approval of the public and our friends.

We invite attention to the Business and Copartnership Directory embraced within the pages of this work, which in the larger Eastern cities is published under separate covers. We furnish with each Directory a subscriber's card, entitling the holder to the privilege of referring to our Directory Library, which contains the Directories of other large cities. These cards will be numbered in duplicate with the book delivered to our subscribers, and a complete register of such numbers will be kept in our office to assist us in tracing up stolen books, and locating Directory Thieves and Borrowers.

In view of the renewed activity of certain schemers and swindlers, it seems advisable to warn the public once more against the fraudulent Directory concerns which have been operating throughout the country for the past few years, collecting thousands of dollars on forged or raised contracts for advertisements in Directories that have no circulation whatever beyond the copies carried by the solicitors. There have been a number of these swindlers arrested in different parts of the country, by both the local authorities and the United States Secret Service, for fraudulent use of the mails, but there are still several gangs at large, operating this confidence game, and so shrewd and efficient are they in their work, that it is only by the greatest care the business public can avoid being duped.

We would advise our patrons in all instances to keep a record of all advertising contracts given, and to insist upon the return of the original contract when the amount is paid. Do not accept a receipt instead, and allow the collector to retain the contracts, as they are held in order to change their date and the name of the proposed publication, and later to collect a second and third time.

Do not sign what they call a "paid voucher," which is a certificate that so much money has been paid for an advertisement. The signatures thus obtained are for future use, and the so-called "voucher" is altered by acid erasures or by so cutting off one end of the artfully worded certificate that the receipt for money paid becomes an order for further payments.

# NEW ATLAS OF CHICAGO

THE first volume includes the portion between Chicago Avenue and Twenty-second Street, Halsted Street and Lake Michigan, and contains about forty plates, each showing the east half or west half of a quarter-section on a scale of 100 feet to one inch. Each quarter-section has been surveyed, and the measured length of each side noted thereon, so that the surplus above the United States dimensions may be seen.

All subdivisions are shown, with the recorded dimensions of all lots, blocks, streets, alleys, boulevards, etc. The position of right of way of all railroads are given in accordance with deed or act of condemnation.

A separate map shows the public land survey by the United States in 1828, with the meander lines of the lake and the river, and the accretion or erosion since that date.

The plats of all subdivisions made before the destruction of the Archives of Cook County by the great fire of October, 1871, are copied from the collection of tracings from the recorded maps of 1863, by Wm. P. Davis, now in possession of Messrs. Handy & Co., and from the manuscript Atlases made by the same hand, now owned by Messrs. Ogden, Sheldon & Co., and by Messrs. Rees, Pierce & Co., which these gentlemen have kindly placed at our disposal. Much important matter has been obtained from original plats, deeds, and abstracts furnished us by private owners. Full marginal notes accompany each plate, giving the description of each subdivision, taken from the deed of the owner, or from the certificate of the surveyor.

PRIVATE MAILING CARDS. Cards must not exceed in size 3 1/2 by 5 1/2 inches. The quality of the cards must be substantially that of the government stationery which weigh about 6 pounds 3 ounces to the thousand. The cards may be of any color. The cards must be placed at the top of the address side; "Private Mailing Card—Authorized by Act of Congress of May 19, 1898."—should be printed in large characters, and printed by printers or stationers for sale, they should also bear in the upper right-hand corner of the address side the words "Private Mailing Card." "Place the postage stamp here," and in the lower left-hand corner the following words should be printed: "This side is for the address." The postage rate applicable to cards for the United States, Canada, and Mexico is two cents. For other countries the rate is two cents. The face of the card is reserved exclusively for postage stamps, and the words "Postage" which may be in writing, printing, by means of a stamp, or by an adhesive label of not more than three-fourths of an inch by one inch in size. The sender may in the same manner indicate his name and address on the face or back of the card, and such addresses and names may be printed on the front if they do not interfere with a perfectly distinct address. No message on the cards may be written either in writing or print; and there may also appear on the message side advertisements, illustrations, and other matter printed, other in black or in colors. There must be attached to every card mailed an adhesive postage stamp of the proper value.

# STREET AND AVENUE GUIDE.

## EXPLANATORY.

The City comprises Ten Divisions, known as the North, South and West Divisions, Hyde Park, Lake, Calumet, Lake View, Jefferson, Austin and Rogers Park.

Streets that cross the Chicago River have the prefix N. North of the River, and W. West of the River, but the prefix E. or S. is (with two or three exceptions) never used. Thus, the correct names are Erie and W. Erie, Lake and W. Lake, Clark and N. Clark, State and N. State, etc.

All east and west streets south of 39th have the prefix W. west of State. Thus, 47th and W. 47th, instead of 47th (H.P.) and 47th (L.), as formerly.

All east and west streets north of Nelson have the prefix W. west of N. Western av. Thus, Lawrence av. and W. Lawrence av. instead of Lawrence av. (L.V.) and Lawrence av. (J.), as formerly.

In the West Division, all streets that cross W. Randolph have the prefix N. or S. Thus, N. Ada, north of Randolph, and S. Ada, south of Randolph. West of Union Park (where W. Randolph ends) W. Lake street is the dividing line.

On any street the relative location of a house is given by running down the column of figures, which are its numbers at the several crossings of the streets that intersect it. The right hand number after crossing is usually given. For example, to find 44 State, it will be seen that 40 is on the corner of Lake, and 60 is on the corner of Randolph; hence 44 is between these two streets. Where no numbers are given, the corners, and often the blocks, are vacant.
